Brooklyn County General Services - Meeting on Jan 18, 2023

- 1 I was appointed by Brooklyn County to be the liaison to BIGAA.
- 2 This was the first County meeting with the newly elected officers including the new chairperson, Charlene.
- 3 A year-end treasurer's report was presented. Income for 2022 was \$5,187.00. Income for 2021 exceeded \$9,000.00. There was a major decline in income. Since expenses were also low, the deficit for 2022 was \$870.67.
- 4 The Brooklyn County budget for 2023 projects a major deficit of \$7,540.89. The actual numbers could be very different, depending on actual income and expenses during this year.
- 5 Brooklyn County has several openings for standing committee chairpersons including: Brooklyn County Spiritual Breakfast, Corrections, Public Information, NY Intergroup Liaison, and Treatment.
- 6 The featured speaker was the new SENY Chairperson, Paola.
- 7 The SENY Convention will take place on Friday March 24 to Sunday March 26 in Tarrytown, NY at the Westchester Marriott. The registration fee is \$25.00. There will be a limited hybrid option. There will be scholarships for those who cannot afford the registration. To volunteer to do service at the convention, write to convention@aaseny.org. Special room rates start at \$137.00 / night.
- 8 We voted to hire a coach bus to transport people to and from the convention on Saturday, March 25. Saturday is the main day of the event. The bus will leave from The Brooklyn Academy of Music at around 7:00AM and it will return around 5:00PM Saturday afternoon. Tickets for the bus are \$25.00.
